Dear Mr. Dennen,

Having reviewed the recent BUD Permit extension request by AP Enterprises, I am concerned that Portsmouth residents in the abutting neighborhoods have endured nearly 4 years of heavy truck traffic, dust, dirt and noise associated with the industrial activity and now will be forced to endure it for another year, or more.

Also, it is surprising to learn, now, that the original site survey for contaminated soils did not identify the additional contaminated area recently approved for remediation. It is presumed the contamination has been confirmed by DEM and that the discovery is not intended to just extend the 8-foot elevation over adjacent uncontaminated soils.


It is well understood that AP Enterprises has undertaken the commercial fill approach in order to finance the 2-foot final cap layer. Given the elapsed time and the unending parade of trucks over the years begs the question: What is the cost of the final two feet of clean topsoil needed to complete the cap and how much money has AP Enterprises accumulated through acceptance of commercial grade fill? If sufficient funds have accumulated then the additional landfill area need not be covered with additional commercial fill.

I do not live in the affected area but, as a Town Council member during the start of the controversial project, I remain sympathetic to Portsmouth citizens living in the area. I have canvassed streets in the immediate vicinity of the project to learn sentiments of the residents. Virtually, all the residents encountered strongly object to the continued activity and disturbing industrial nuisance imposed on the neighborhood.

I have attached the petition with signatures of residents opposed to extending the capping permit.

Mindful of the health hazard the landfill represents, the financial challenges of remediation and DEM's compelling interest in seeing the project through, I request on behalf of affected residents that any and all follow-on activity approved, be pursued with haste and completed by a date certain.

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

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
